- COURSE DESCRIPTION -

Participants must have completed the CDOT Erosion Control Supervisor (ECS) Certification training (or equivalent) prior to registration. Pre-registration and liability waivers are required. Cancellations must be made within 3 days of the class or you will not be allowed to attend any session for the next 1 year.
